

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, INDIANA, ESTABLISHING STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF PASONAGE STREET AND NOLL STREET, HUDSON.

WHEREAS, the Town of Hudson, pursuant to Indiana State Statute, has the authority to establish traffic regulation and ordinances on public streets within the town of Hudson and;

WHEREAS, the control of vehicle traffic at the various intersections on public roads and streets are in the public interest and safety of the citizens of the Town of Hudson, and;

WHEREAS, the residents of the Town of Hudson have perceived an unsafe condition and petitioned to increase safety at the intersection of Parsonage Street and Noll Street by placing stop signs on the through street, and;

WHEREAS, traffic southbound on Noll Street will have difficulty proceeding if required to stop in periods of ice, snow, and/or condition creating slick roads, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Hudson thereby deems it necessary to modify the flow of traffic at that intersection in the Town of Hudson, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL, TOWN OF HUDSON, STEUBEN COUNTY, INDIANA, that traffic within said intersection shall be controlled as follows:

1. Traffic northbound on Noll Street shall stop at the intersection. A warning sign shall be posted that the intersection is a two way stop.
2. Traffic southbound shall not stop at the intersection.
3. Traffic on Parsonage Street shall stop as per the current sign. A warning sign shall be posted that the intersection is a two way stop.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any violation of this Ordinance shall subject the violator to the fines and court costs associated with traffic offenses and violations as established by the Fremont Town Court.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that after passage of this Ordinance and any publication required by law, the Town shall erect stop signs and warning signs as set forth above.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council and any legal publication necessary.
